

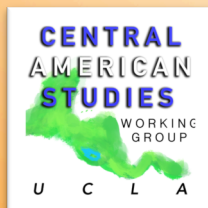
DOCUMENTING THE UNDOCUMENTED: LATINX NARRATIVE AND 'ILLEGAL' IMMIGRATION
