About the artist: Salomón Huerta is an artist. Born in Tijuana (Baja California, Mexico), he was raised in Boyle Heights' Ramona Gardens public housing project. He obtained his BFA from Art Center College of Design in Pasadena and MFA from UCLA School of Art. Huerta first gained critical acclaim and success for his minimalist portraits of the backs of people's heads and color-saturated depictions of houses. His artwork has been exhibited in influential exhibitions, galleries and museums, such as the 2000 Whitney Biennial in New York, the Gagosian Gallery in London, England, and Studio La Città in Verona, Italy. This summer, he will participate in a major exhibition, "Home—So Different, So Appealing," at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA).
