Congratulations to [María Elena González](#) on her participation in *Home - So Different, So Appealing: Art from the Americas since 1957* at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art!

Organized in collaboration with the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, *HOME - So Different, So Appealing* features U.S. Latino and Latin American artists from the late 1950s to the present who have used the deceptively simple idea of "home" as a powerful lens through which to view the profound socioeconomic and political transformations in the hemisphere. The exhibition runs from June 11 to October 15, 2017.

María Elena González's *Magic Carpet/Home* (2003/2017), the only outdoor public sculpture in the exhibition, has been recreated on the grounds of the museum and, in the words of co-curator Chon Noriega, "serves as an introduction and guidepost" to the exhibition. This exhibition is part of Pacific Standard Time: LA/LA, a far reaching and ambitious exploration of Latin America and Latino art in dialogue with Los Angeles. Supported by grants from the Getty Foundation, Pacific Standard Time: LA/LA takes place from September 2017 through January 2018 at more than 70 cultural institutions across Southern California, from Los Angeles to Palm Springs, and from San Diego to Santa Barbara.
